I refer to your request for information dated 31 July 2018 and my response of 2 November.

In response to the queries which you raise I would comment:

 I attach a list of the buildings and land which the Council has disposed of from 2014-2015 to the date of your request. The disposals have either been on the open market or to 'special purchasers' where, for example, they own the adjoining land and have made a request to purchase it. The disposals, have been made at market value or, more accurately, for the best consideration which could reasonably be obtained.

The list indicates the person to whom the land or buildings were transferred except where the disposals were to individuals. The disclosure of the identity of the individuals would be contrary to the data protection provisions and this is a point which you acknowledge in your initial request for information. I will let you have a partial refusal notice relating to this data protection issue.

- The Council acquired the land and buildings at 4/4a Corney Square, Penrith. The
 date of the acquisition was 27 June 2017. The purchase price was £221,622. The
 properties were acquired from a private individual.
- In accordance with the Council's records the Council had 398 assets at the beginning of the period 2014-2015 and 375 on the date the request was received.
