- 1. This return **must** be completed in accordance with Schedule 11 paragraph 39 and sent to the Council within three months of the draw (or final draw) taking place.
- 2. At least 20% of the lottery proceeds must be applied to the purposes of the society.
- 3. No single prize may be worth more than £25,000.
- 4. The total value of tickets per single lottery must not exceed £20,000 and the total aggregate value per calendar year must not exceed £250,000.
- 5. It is an offence under Section 342 of the Gambling Act 2005 to give false or misleading information.
