Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 notice is given that Eden District Council formally adopted the Management of Conservation Areas Supplementary Planning Document on 24 March 2011.

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) provides generic guidance on the management of all conservation areas in Eden as well as identifying specific issues in individual conservation areas. The SPD will be a material consideration in the determination of planning applications.
