Delegated Decision Regarding Application for Designation of Asby as a Neighbourhood Area

1. Decision

I hereby exercise power under section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and all other powers delegated to me, by the Council's Executive on 1 July 2014, to designate the 'Asby Neighbourhood Area' as a neighbourhood area (for the purposes of section 61G(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.

2. Reason for Decision
