Further to the Inspectors request regarding the deliverability of the sites previously promoted by Cumbria County Council. Please find below some further detail in respect of these sites.

Penrith

Kemply Bank, land to the south west of Penrith Fire Station. This site offers a suitable opportunity to provide up to 2 acres of deliverable employment land. The site is in one ownership and free from any know constraints. Access is achievable from the A686 through an existing route (U3482) which currently serves the fire station complex.

Site of Tynefield Drive – Cumbria County Council would like to withdraw their submission regarding the promotion of this site for allocation.

Kirkby Stephen

Land to the rear Kirkby Stephen Fire Station, Christian Head. This site could provide 5- 10 residential units to the housing target for Kirkby Stephen should the other proposed allocation be unable to meet the requirement. The site is in one ownership and free from any know constraints. Access is achievable from the existing access (all within the ownership of Cumbria County Council) which serves the care home and fire station.
