Lazonby neighbourhood plan consultation opens

LAZONBY'S draft neighbourhood plan, which has been developed by a working group set up by Lazonby Parish Council, is now open for consultation.

Members of the public are invited to view the plan and submit their comments.

Neighbourhood planning is a way for local communities to set out how they wish their area to develop in the future and allows them to write their own plan which, once adopted, is used to help determine planning applications.

The draft plan for Lazonby covers the period 2014-2029 and includes matters such as design and conservation, the protection of open spaces, housing and rural business development and micro-energy schemes.

The geographical area covered by the plan (the "neighbourhood area") is the same as the Lazonby parish boundary and includes the village and all surrounding countryside within the parish.

Consultation drop-in sessions are at Lazonby vil-

lage hall on Wednesday from 7pm to 9pm and on Saturday, 12th August, from 10am to noon.

Paper copies of the documents are also available for inspection at Penrith Town Hall, Mansion House, Penrith, Penrith library, Lazonby village hall, Lakes and Dales Co-op, Lazonby, and at St. Nicholas Church, Lazonby.

The results of the consultation will be submitted to Eden Council and to an independent examiner for consideration. If the plan is approved by the examiner, it will then be put to a local referendum.
